## **PARKING**

Effective September 5, we will begin towing vehicles who are either a) parked in a spot without tags or b) parked in an area that is not a parking spot. Council has tried to be relaxed about enforcing parking bylaws, but it has reached the point where cars are parking in illegal spots and hindering the ability of neighbors to park, or for emergency vehicles to access our streets. As it has been years since we have towed anyone, we are providing a one-month warning for people to adjust to the situation.

# POOL & CABANA

With the summer season in place the cabana and pool are being actively used. Please review the bylaws to ensure everyone can enjoy the pool. Please note from our bylaws the following is not permitted:

- cause unreasonable noise;
- eat, drink, or smoke in the Pool or Sauna or the area surrounding the Pool or Sauna;
- use or carry glass containers of any kind;

# POOL & CABANA RESURFACING

The council is looking to resurface the pool deck after the end of this summer. ## **RECYCLING**

When the recycling is picked up each week, the bins are not put back by the recycling crews, which obviously causes problems with parking and access.
