PARKING

Major parking issues are currently impacting the strata. Parking infractions are being noted and towing has begun. This is a bylaw infraction and therefore may also result in fines. Please note that:

- 1. Tags must be <u>clearly displayed</u> in the front window of a vehicle parked in a tag spot or double-parked in acceptable locations.
- 2. Double parking in the cul-de-sac carports is strictly prohibited.
- 3. Parking in Fire Lanes is strictly prohibited.

For any parking infractions the vehicle may be towed at the owner's expense. Please refer to the Parking bylaws for more information and note that some bylaws were also updated during our Dec 6 AGM.

Please do not let children play in roadside snow banks, this is not a safe play area.
