## Evergreens – low maintenance shade / sun tolerant



Handsome evergreen shrub forms a many-branched, dome-shaped mound. Rich green leaves back large clusters of very fragrant, creamy-white flowers. This form acts as a pollinizer to the female forms, which bear ornamental fruit. Likes partial sun and shade, grows to 2 -5 feet, spreads 3-6 feet wide, low maintenance, watering during dry spells required

Euonymus Paloma blanca (image above on the left), this compact shrub with dense, dark green foliage welcomes spring with a harmony of brilliant white new leaves. An outstanding choice for a low border or hedge plant, or as a garden accent. The small, upright form fits well into mixed containers and requires little to no pruning. Evergreen reaches 1 ½ - 2 feet high and wide.



We recommend using a variety of astilbes, hucheras and hostas. The areas to fill will need some color and texture, these perennials offer a colourful low maintenance option that does well in shady areas. These plants will die away in the winter and need to be cut back but will come back each year fuller and can be spilt in the future and put in other areas of the property to create synergy in the landscape design.

The layout will have spacing in mind for long term growth to avoid future landscape errors that can be costly. Plants will come in 1 gallon pots or smaller.
