SUBJECT: 2ND NOTIFICATION OF UNACCEPTABLE MATERIALS IN RECYCLING RECEPTACLES AT 9020 LYRA PL, BURNABY, BC

As per the letter dated 2024 July 19, you are receiving a second and final letter in regard to your property located at the above address. During routine collection on 2024 August 9, we noticed your glass bin contained propane, which should not be placed in these recycling receptacles.

For your information, the Burnaby Solid Waste and Recycling Bylaw 2010, Bylaw No. 12875, and amendments, regulates the use and storage of garbage, yard waste/food scraps and recycling receptacles for multi-family properties. Pertinent to the subject of recycling collection, Section 6(2)(a) reads as follows:

<u>Section 6(2)(a)</u> Every owner or occupier of premises must place recyclable materials designated by the Engineer for collection service into a recycling receptacle without contamination.

Please ensure your green bin does not contain unacceptable materials. If unacceptable materials continue to be placed in your green bin receptacle the City may be required to proceed with enforcement of the bylaw and issue a violation notice. The penalty for violations under Section 6(2)(a) is \$500.
